

The services offered will be, non-medical essential visit to hospitals for dialysis treatment, pre-natal checkups of pregnant women, post-surgical appointment, baby immunization, grocery or medicine requirement of senior citizens, visits to bank, pension offices by senior citizens or ladies and such. Adding to the services of Mahindra, STT will cater to hitherto uncovered areas like Ibrahimpatnam, Adibatla, Choutuppal. The service would be available 24 hours. Vehicles would be increased depending on the load of calls or requests. The citizens can avail the service by calling the Corona Control Room on 9490617234 who will direct the STT vehicle to the concerned.

Health check for migrant workers

Rachakonda Police, TISS already conducting socio-economic, need assessment survey

In yet another proactive measure for migrant workers, Rachakonda Police started medical camps for them and their kin across the Commission limits. The Rachakonda Police along with the Tata Institute of Social Sciences (TISS) are already conducting socio-economic and need assessment survey of migrant labourers who are currently stranded here due to the lockdown.

So far nearly 5500 migrant workers and family members living in Jawaharnagar, Neredmet, LB Nagar, Vanaathalapuram and Meerpet were surveyed. According to the police, during the survey, the needs for ration and food were addressed either by the police or forwarded to the GHMC and district administration for necessary intervention. "Similarly, it has been felt that there are pregnant women, children, and elderly persons among these groups who require medical check-ups," said Mahesh M Bhagwat, Police Commissioner, Rachakonda. Hence, medical volunteers have taken up health check-ups for migrant workers and families residing in Rachakonda Police jurisdiction. As part of this, on Sunday a team of doctors from Sunrags Hospital with their teams visited Meerpet and conducted health check-ups for migrant workers. An ambulance has been provided from Rachakonda Police headquarters for the purpose apart from several general medicines required for each camp, personal protective equipment for the doctors, masks, sanitizers and face shield. "These checks and survey will be continued in Rachakonda where migrant workers are more in number and in need of immediate medical attention," Bhagwat said.
