

Newly elected RKSC governing body meets CP





Mega Traffic Awareness and training conducted for drivers

Rachakonda Security Council (RKSC) Traffic Safety Forum organised a Traffic Awareness Training Programme for drivers, which was attended by over 780 drivers, at Srinivasa Tours & Travels Garage, Auto Nagar, Vanasthalipuram.

The Chief Guest at the awareness training session was Sri V. Sreenivasulu, DCP Traffic – Rachakonda. The Awareness Sessions were conducted by Sri Joseph Traffic Inspector, TTI. Sri Naveen Reddy, ACP - Traffic, Rachakonda, Mrs Anusha, Motor vehicle inspector, Ibrahimpatnam, who addressed about Road Safety and also administered an oath of safety and security to the drivers and supervisors of Sri Srinivasa Tours & Travels, Surya Travels, Sreeja Travels and TCS, who attended the session..

Addressing the drivers, Sri Sreenivasulu, DCP said that India was endowed with the largest human capital in the world and it was important to safeguard their lives. Road safety is amongst the most crucial aspects and overconfidence and high-speed driving caused most accidents on the roads. Even experienced drivers are prone to carelessness due to overconfidence. He advised the drivers need to be cautious at all times.

Mr Naveen Reddy, ACP, spoke about the drivers need to be vigilant at all times. The world moves everyday due to the drivers and it is utmost important for the drivers to be mentally and physically fit at all times.

Smt. Anusha, Motor Vehicle Inspector, Ibrahimpatnam addressing the drivers stressed on the importance of vehicles being equipped with safety measures and also the need for Drivers to always carry all necessary papers like Registration, license, Insurance, First-aid kit, etc.

Speaking to the drivers, Mr Joseph, TTI Inspector said "On an average about 50 to 60 people lose their lives in road accidents in Telangana every day". "Driving as an occupation is very divine, for the drivers are transporting people to their destinations every day, and it's their utmost responsibility to be aware of the traffic rules and follow them judiciously."

Mr Koti Srinivasa Rao, Jt. Secretary, Road Safety Forum, spoke about the safety measures in place to ensure the safety of drivers and the road users. Srinivasa Tours and Travels has put in place speed-locks for their vehicles and provides regular training to the drivers on safety.
