


Women's Forum

Vision Statement



An online panel discussion 'Use and abuse of Technology', on the occasion of World Day Against Trafficking In Persons, was organized by Rachakonda Security Council – Cyber Security Forum.

During the discussion Mahesh M Bhagwat shared insights into human trafficking with global perspective and the Indian scenarios and explained how various circumstances in the society force people into the trap of trafficking.

He spoke about various types of trafficking like sex trafficking, domestic servitude, forced labour, organ trade, cyber frauds, camel Jockeying, circus, child pornography, contract marriage, adoption etc. Mahesh Bhagwat detailed the ways to stop trafficking, rescue, rehabilitation, restoration, repatriation and reintegration and strategy for prevention, protection and prosecution.

He also shared the initiatives of Rachakonda police and the efforts gone into closing 170 apartment flats / lodges/ guest houses used as brothels by taking an order from Sub Divisional/Executive Magistrate.

The panel discussion was moderated by Latha Ramasubramanyam, Joint Secretary, Women's forum Rachakonda Security Council.

Hon'ble Education Minister Sabitha Indra Reddy has inaugurated training center for Tailoring classes to vulnerable women from minorities at Pahadisharif PS. Innovative program initiated by Rachakonda Police in collaboration with RKSC Rachakonda & District Rural Development Agency

Education minister P. Sabitha Indra Reddy has inaugurated a skill development centre for women at Pahadishareef, set up by the Rachakonda police in collaboration with Rachakonda Security Council and Ranga Reddy District Rural Development Agency(DRDA).

As part of the programme, 50 women will be trained in tailoring for two months and a certificate will be given by the DRDA, Ranga Reddy district. The programme 'SHE ERA' was conceived, after a survey in Pahadishareef and Balapur areas.

The survey found that a majority of the people in these areas are living below the poverty line, resulting in several social issues.





LEGAL BYTES

STALKING (Sec.354D of IPC)

If a man follows or contacts (or attempts) a woman despite a clear indication of disinterest by her, or monitors the use of internet, email or other electronic communication by her, then he shall be punished under this section. Maximum punishment is imprisonment of 3 years and /or fine and 5 years in case of subsequent conviction.

LEGAL BYTES

Voyeurism (Sec.354 C of IPC)

If a man watches or captures the image of a woman in a private act or disseminates such an image, he shall be punished under this section. A private act includes an act where the victim does not expect to be observed by the man or any other person at his behest. If the victim consents to the capture of the image but not to dissemination, then such dissemination shall be punishable.

Punishment in case of first conviction is imprisonment not less than one year which may extend to 3 years and fine and on a second conviction if he repeats then punishment may be imprisonment for a term not less than 3 years but which may extend to 7 years and fine.





An online panel discussion ‘Use and abuse of Technology’, on the occasion of World Day Against Trafficking In Persons, was organized by Rachakonda Security Council – Cyber Security Forum. During the discussion Mahesh M Bhagwat shared insights into human trafficking with global perspective and the Indian scenarios and explained how various circumstances in the society force people into the trap of trafficking. He spoke about various types of trafficking like sex trafficking, domestic servitude, forced labour, organ trade, cyber frauds, camel Jockeying, circus, child pornography, contract marriage, adoption etc. Mahesh Bhagwat detailed the ways to stop trafficking, rescue, rehabilitation, restoration, repatriation and reintegration and strategy for prevention, protection and prosecution. He also shared the initiatives of Rachakonda police and the efforts gone into closing 170 apartment flats / lodges/ guest houses used as brothels by taking an order from Sub Divisional/Executive Magistrate. The panel discussion was moderated by Latha Ramasubramanyam, Joint Secretary, Women’s forum Rachakonda Security Council. The session was attended by about 1200+ participants along with the RKSC volunteers.




