

# ANTI-DRUG SUMMIT 2024




The Anti-Drug Summit 2024 had a grand kickoff, organized by the Rachakonda Security Council in collaboration with the Rachakonda Police. G. Sudheer Babu, IPS, Commissioner of Police and Chairman of the Rachakonda Security Council, inaugurated the summit at BITS Pilani, Hyderabad. The event, which aimed to raise awareness about drug use and its prevention, brought together over 3,000 students from 200 educational institutions across the Rachakonda Commissionerate.

The Chief Guest, Sandeep Shandilya, IPS, Director of the Telangana State AntiNarcotic Bureau (TSNAB), spoke about the devastating impact of drug use on society, particularly on the youth. He highlighted how many promising students have ruined their education and careers by indulging in drugs and other prohibited substances.

As part of the summit's awareness efforts, a group discussion was held, involving students from twelve colleges, each represented by a team of 20 students. The discussions, guided by counselors from the Telangana Psychologists Association, focused on the most prevalent factors contributing to drug abuse. The resolutions from these discussions were signed by Commissioner G. Sudheer Babu, IPS, who reaffirmed the State Government's commitment to eradicating drug abuse.

He urged the police to make the fight against drugs a collective social responsibility, turning it into a movement to achieve a drug-free society. He also mentioned that 90 pubs were inspected before the New Year to prevent any untoward incidents during the celebrations. Commissioner Sudheer Babu emphasized the dangers of drug use, explaining that while drugs may initially provide excitement, they quickly lead to addiction and a loss of control, resulting in many misfortunes in life. He warned that intoxicants are highly addictive and should be avoided, as drug addiction leads to a miserable existence.



Addressing the gathering, Rachakonda Commissioner of Police, Sri Sudheer Babu IPS, urged students never to experiment with drugs, even once in their lifetime. He assured them that awareness drives would be conducted in all colleges and hostels while stringent actions would be taken to dismantle the entire drug network, from dealers and peddlers to consumers. He noted that the Rachakonda police have invoked a total of 12 Preventive Detention (PD) cases since the beginning of the year and have seized drugs and other prohibited psychotropic substances worth around 5 crore rupees.

He encouraged students to report any knowledge of drug sellers or users to the police, which would help in breaking the supply chain. He pointed out that drug dealers typically do not consume the substances themselves but instead target the youth. The Commissioner emphasized the importance of more awareness programs to combat drug abuse and the use of other prohibited substances. He advised the youth to stay away from drugs, stressing that drug use would severely damage their physical and mental health.

The Commissioner also urged students to actively participate in drug awareness campaigns and contribute to creating a drug-free society. He commended the efforts of the Rachakonda Security Council in the fight against drugs and mentioned the successful collaboration between the Rachakonda Commissionerate and RKSC in organizing numerous awareness campaigns in various engineering colleges. Additionally, he highlighted the need for dedicated student clubs in every college to combat the drug menace and raise awareness among their peers.

Speaking at the event, Cyberabad Commissioner of Police, Sri Avinash Mohanty IPS, emphasized that drug use is a destructive habit and strongly advised students to steer clear of it. He shared insights into how many officers and successful individuals have overcome significant challenges to achieve their goals. Mohanty referenced the recent Bollywood film 12th Fail, which tells the inspiring success story of IPS officer Manoj Sharma, who was also his batchmate during IPS training.

He reiterated that maintaining a healthy lifestyle and adopting good habits are crucial for achieving success. Special Chief Guest Ms. Erin Fischer, Chief of Investigations for the Overseas Criminal Investigation Program at the U.S. Consulate, presided over the event and shared her perspective on drug abuse. Neuropsychologist Dr. Ramya Shruti D and Dr. Divya Devulapally informed the students about the detrimental effects of drug abuse on mental and physical health and urged them to say no to drugs. Education expert Dr. Vangeepuram Sreenatha Chary, a Guinness World Record holder, motivated the students to stay focused and resist temptations. He also proposed the inclusion of drug abuse education in academic curricula to instill the impact of such abuse early in students' lives.

Motivational speaker Sri Sudheer Sandra was a highlight of the event, sharing real-life stories of individuals whose addiction led them from success to disaster. The summit underscored the importance of a comprehensive approach to tackling drug abuse, including education, prevention, treatment, and support services. It served as a platform for stakeholders to form partnerships, share knowledge, and take action toward a drug-free future.

# INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

## IWD 4K WALKTHON

In celebration of International Women's Day, the Rachakonda Police Commissionerate and the Rachakonda Security Council organized a 4-kilometer walkathon in Hyderabad's Rachakonda area. The event was designed to promote gender equality and raise awareness about women's rights. Commissioner Tarun Joshi, IPS, along with RKSC office bearers, led the walkathon from the ECIL office. Participants walked in unison to highlight the importance of equal opportunities for both women and men. RKSC recognized the achievements of women and reaffirmed its commitment to building a more inclusive society.

## ACUPRESSURE

A successful health camp initiative titled "Language of Healing - Acupuncture" was organized at BITS by the Rachakonda Security Council (RKSC). Under the leadership of Dr. Tarun Joshi, I.P.S., Commissioner of Police and Chairman of RKSC, the self-health healing camp was held in collaboration with the COSMIC Institute of Acupuncture and Naturopathy (CIAN) to celebrate International Women's Day. Acupuncture, an 8,000-year-old therapy documented by Sage Agastya Maha Munni, has largely been forgotten over the years. Dr. Sudhakar, the Founder Director of CIAN (Ad.D.Acu., BEMS, M.D. (EH), NDDY), spearheaded the effort to revive awareness of this ancient Indian healing practice. CIAN, founded by a team of five, including Dr. Sudhakar, Healer Smt. Kanaka Durga, Healer Sri Chidambaram, Healer Smt. Jyothi, and Healer Smt. Sreedevi, has treated nearly a lakh of patients and graduated around 800-1000 students over the past decade. The awareness session saw enthusiastic participation from faculty, parents, and students. Smt. Yogeshwari Devi, Dean of BITS, praised RKSC for this unique initiative and expressed interest in continuing the sessions. A team of 11 healers, including Ms. Harika, Mr. Bhavani Kumar, Mr. Santosh, Smt. Kavitha, Smt. Shivarajani, Mr. Haridhar, Smt. Sabita, Smt. Vijayalakshmi, Smt. Veena, Mr. Satyanarayan, and Mr. Raghunath, provided healing services to around 85 patients. RKSC coordinators Smt. Archana Manne, Chief Coordinator Savithri M, and forum members Mr. Surya, Smt. Nikath, and Smt. Radhika also played key roles in the initiative.


# GOVERNOR DR. TAMILISAI SOUNDARARAJAN






