

Dear Readers,

My appeal to the citizens of Rachakonda living in the eastern part of Hyderabad is on the similar lines as advised by our respected Chief Minister KCR Garu and our Honorable Prime Minister Narendra Modi ji that people should stay indoors and not venture out barring those carrying out essential services who have been provided dedicated passes for commutation.

Furthermore, for fulfillment of daily needs of a family, I would urge only one person per family to head out that too only in the radius of 3 km, for purchasing medicines, groceries and vegetables etc.

The stores providing essential goods will operate from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM, post this timeline, only pharmacies, diagnostic centers and hospitals will operate. Any person violating this rule should be assured that they will be charged under Sec 188 of IPC. Currently, we have impounded more than 6000 vehicles who have broken the law. I would also impress upon the commutation decorum for people using own conveyance. Only one person on a two-wheeler and two people on a four-wheeler are to commute.

I would also like to inform that the law enforcement agencies will be monitoring all movements through app and for people who will violate the 3 km radius rule, a challan will be generated. To avoid all this, stay safe, stay indoors, travel safe and cooperate with the law enforcement agencies. 9 zones in Malkajigiri, L.B. Nagar zones declared as containment zones & strict lock down is observed in those area to prevent community transmission of COVID-19. 600 police personnel are posted at 42 check post on 24x7 duties.

Stay home stay safe to prevent transmission of COVID 19 is my sincere appeal to all residents of Rachakonda.

Rachakonda Police and Mahindra Logistics started "Alyte cab service, available 24/7, to provide emergency transport to senior citizens, women, physically challenged people, destitute etc. for medical emergencies, financial services etc., in tri Commissionerate jurisdiction receiving overwhelming response.

Health checkup of police personal on duty

Maintaining essential goods supply chain

To keep supply chain intact during lock down period 1000 truck drivers are being served packed food at Panthangi and Bibinagar toll gate daily.

Migrant Laborer food distribution

Migrant laborers are representative of development of Telangana state and, taking care of them is our social responsibility in lock down period. Under the leadership of Addl. DCP Admin K. Shilpavalli a special cell is working to provide free food and groceries to migrant workers from different parts of the country. Volunteer Mukesh is coordinating these activities. 2000 people getting benefitted directly from this daily. Additionally, more than 18000 migrant laborers benefitted through local police
