Traffic Marshals organise Mega Awareness Road Show



Secunderabad June 06, 2021: Traffic Marshals of Rachakonda Security Council (RKSC), a select group of civil society volunteers, trained by the Rachakonda Police, organised a **Mega Awareness Road Show** on Sunday June 6, 2021 on the NH 65, from LB Nagar to Choutuppal.

The drive was flagged off by DCP Traffic of Rachakonda Police Mr D. Srinivas from the Sarooranagar Indoor stadium at 11.30 AM. About 30 Traffic Marshals of the RKSC then embarked on the road show that stopped at Vansthalipuram X roads, Hayatnagar X Roads and culminating at Choutuppal in Yadadri Bhuvanagiri district, under the Rachakonda Police limits. Speaking on the occasion Mr Srinivas said "it is truly inspiring to see people from various walks of life with successful careers, sparing their time for serving the society".

The road show led by the RKSC Traffic Marshals Coordinator Dr Raghuvveer, highlighted the need for adhering to Covid19 safety protocols.
